THIS MESSAGE ANNOUNCES THE FORTY-EIGHTH ANNUAL AVIATION BOATSWAIN'S MATE ASSOCIATION WORKING GROUP BEING HELD 05-09 AUGUST 2019 AT RENAISSANCE PORTSMOUTH-NORFOLK WATERFRONT HOTEL, 425 WATER STREET, PORTSMOUTH, VA 23704. HOTEL RESERVATIONS CAN BE MADE THROUGH THE HOTEL'S RESERVATIONS DEPARTMENT AT (757) 673-3000.

CALLERS MUST REFER TO THE GROUP NAME ABMA TO BOOK AT THE GROUP RATE. A LIMITED NUMBER OF ROOMS HAVE BEEN BLOCKED FOR THE ABMA FROM 31 JULY THROUGH 12 AUGUST 2019 AND MUST BE BOOKED BY 13 JULY 2019.

2. FOR THE LAST 48 YEARS THE AVIATION BOATSWAIN'S MATE ASSOCIATION HAS SERVED AS THE PREMIER DISCUSSION FORUM TO HARVEST SOLUTIONS IN THE FURTHERING OF SAFETY AND OPERATIONAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR ALL AVIATION DECK SYSTEMS. THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF THIS FORUM IS TO BRING TOGETHER INDUSTRY, GOVERNMENT SERVICE AND FLEET SUBJECT MATTER EXPERTS IN AVIATION DECK SYSTEMS ACROSS ALL DISCIPLINES (FUEL SYSTEMS TO HANDLING, FIREFIGHTING/RESCUE AND AIRCRAFT LAUNCH AND RECOVERY SYSTEMS) TO DISCUSS CONTINUED IMPROVEMENT INITIATIVES IN SUPPORT OF NAVAL AVIATION SAFETY, TRAINING AND READINESS ABOARD AIRCRAFT CARRIERS, AMPHIBIOUS ASSAULT SHIPS, AIR CAPABLE SHIPS AND SHORE FACILITIES. OVER THE YEARS, SENIOR MILITARY OFFICIALS HAVE SUPPORTED THE ABMA ANNUAL WORKING GROUPS FOR THE BENEFIT IT YIELDS IN SUPPORT OF THE NAVAL AVIATION ENTERPRISE. THIS SUPPORT IS

SOLIDIFIED BY A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT SIGNED IN 2013 BY COMMANDER, NAVAL AIR SYSTEMS COMMAND WITH THE ABMA. BENEFITS HAVE RANGED FROM EQUIPMENT UPGRADES TO TRAINING IMPROVEMENTS AND PROCEDURAL CHANGES WHICH HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED FLIGHT OPERATIONS AND SAFETY AT SEA AND ASHORE. THE RESULTS OF EACH WORKSHOP ARE OFFICIALLY SUBMITTED AS ACTION ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION VIA THE RESOURCE SPONSOR (OPNAV N98) TO THE CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS (CNO) AS IMPROVEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS. ADDITIONALLY, THESE RECOMMENDATIONS ARE STRONGLY CONSIDERED DURING PROGRAMMATIC BUDGET DISCUSSIONS TO ENSURE THE VOICE OF THE FLEET IS REPRESENTED AND IN DIRECT ALIGNMENT WITH PROGRAM OBJECTIVES IN THE OUT-YEARS.

3. REQUEST LOCAL COMMANDS CANVASS THEIR FLEET PROFESSIONALS AND ASSESS WHETHER OR NOT THEY CAN SUPPORT THIS VENUE. THE FEEDBACK OF FLEET PROFESSIONALS IS IMPERATIVE TO THE ADVANCEMENT OF THE NAVAL AVIATION ENTERPRISE'S SAFETY GOALS AND THE IMPROVEMENT OF FLEET PROCESSES IN ITS PURSUIT OF ATTAINING CONSISTENCY IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF EQUIPMENT REPAIR PROCEDURES, TRAINING, AND POLICIES. FURTHER, THE VENUE WILL ALSO SERVE TO ADDRESS A CRITICAL COATING/NON-SKID QUALITY CONTROL CONCERN AFFECTING FLIGHT DECKS ACROSS THE FLEET. TO THIS END, THE SOCIETY FOR PROTECTIVE COATINGS (SSPC) WILL PROVIDE AN INSTRUCTOR TO SHARE INFORMATION TO AVIATION BOATSWAIN'S MATES UTILIZING THE NAVSEA STANDARD ITEM 009-32 WHICH INCLUDES CLEANING AND PAINTING REQUIREMENTS, PRESERVATION OF SHIPS IN SERVICE, ASSESSMENT OF DUST ON STEEL SURFACES BEING PREPARED FOR PAINTING AND NONSKID APPLICATION, NECESSARY SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND NONSKID

REMOVAL PROCEDURES IN SUPPORT OF CREATING AN ORGANIC QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTOR WORKFORCE TO MINIMIZE/ERADICATE AV-8 AND STVL-F35B ENGINE FOREIGN OBJECT DAMAGE (FOD) DUE TO DELAMINATING/FAILED NON-SKID. ALL LOCAL COMMANDS ARE REQUESTED TO SUPPORT THE 2019 ABMA WORKING GROUP VIA TEMPORARY ASSIGNED DUTY (TAD) ORDERS. THE EVENT WILL FOLLOW ALL TENETS OF MILITARY PROTOCOL, THEREFORE, ALL ATTENDING ACTIVE DUTY MEMBERS ON ORDERS MUST SURRENDER THEIR DOCUMENTS TO BE STAMPED AT CHECK-IN TIME MAKING THE WORKING GROUP THEIR ASSIGNED PLACE OF DUTY FOR THE DURATION OF THE WORKING GROUP.
